<u>Session 1</u> – Theory (1/2 hour): Equisimulator demonstration of position and absorption of the movement in halt, walk, sitting trot, rising trot and canter.

<u>Session 2</u> – Practical (1 hour): Workshop in groups of 3 riders. Each rider is assessed and corrected for basic position and absorption of movement on the Equisimulator. Watching riders learn how to identify and correct faults.

<u>Session 3</u> - Practical (1 hour): Workshop in groups of 3 riders. Riders work on specific areas that they wish to improve on the Equisimulator, and may ride in their own saddle (optional) to help transfer skills.

<u>Session 4 or 5</u>– Practical (1 hour semi private OR ½ hour private lesson): Lesson on your horse. Put your new skills into practice and learn to incorporate them into a schooling session, riding in balance and applying light aids with precise timing.

<u>Sentient Riding mini-comp</u> - Special classical dressage competition, purpose-written to assess riding skills regardless of horse's level. All levels catered to, from walk only to approx. novice level.

All sessions are taught by Diana Waters, EA level 1 Dressage coach, BHSAI and Enlightened Equitation Teacher, except the independent practice sessions which are unsupervised to allow you time and space to experiment or practice.

Prices do not include venue hire or travel. Travel costs are additional, at approx. \$50 per hour travel time from Ettalong Beach (shared between all participants), plus accommodation/food costs if staying overnight.
